



Indoor Tape Shape Game

You will need:

- Painters tape
- Indoor open space



Activity:

- Use the painters tape to put a variety of shapes letters and/or numbers on your floor.
- Ask your child to stand on their favorite shape.
- Give them instructions to follow, which will lead them to their next destination (for example: "bear crawl to the square", "hop like a Frog to the T", "Run to the rectangle").
